1) BHILWARA DISTRICT;

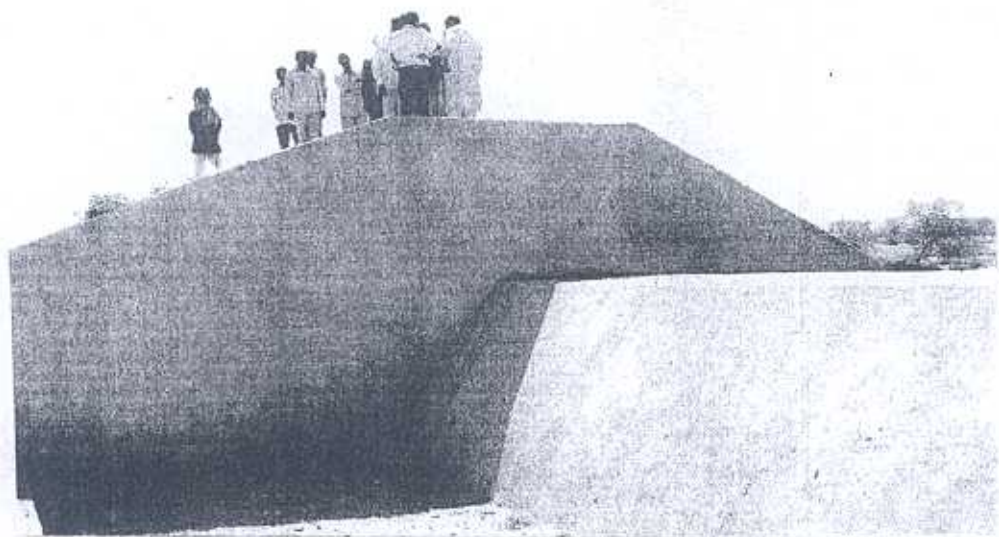

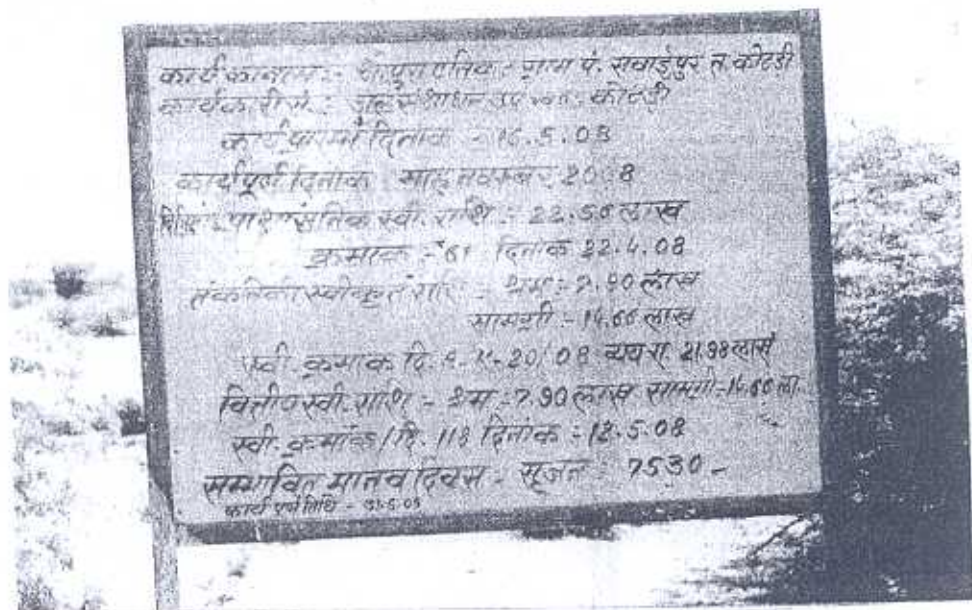
2) KOTRI BLOCK:

Inspected the work spot of Sopura Anicut. This work done with an expenditure of Rs.22.56 lakhs and work implemented satisfactorily.



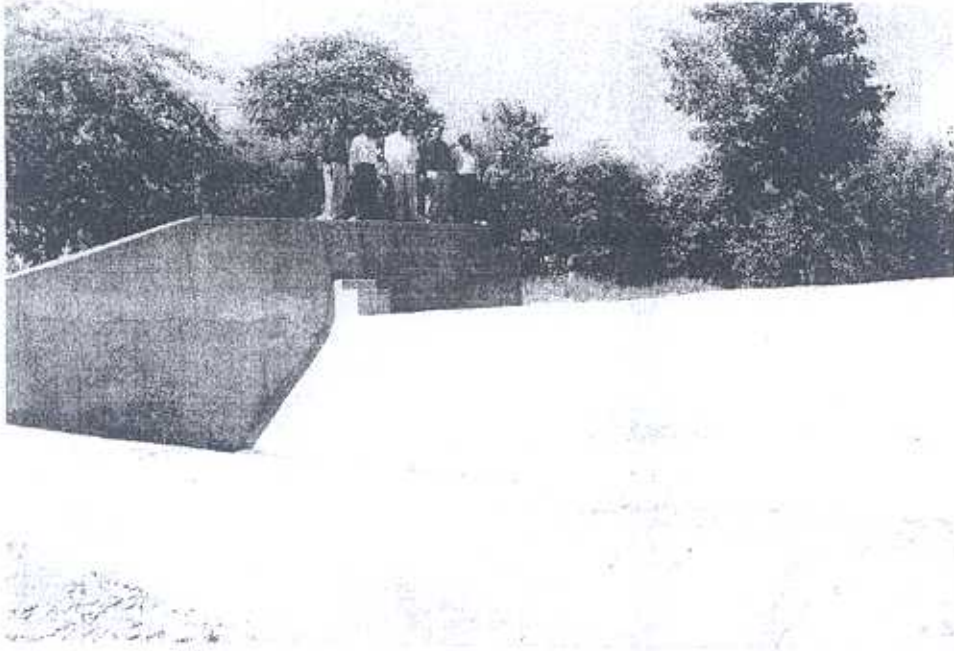

Inspected the work spot of Semal Anicut. This work done with an expenditure of Rs.8.31 lakhs and this work is also done satisfactorily.

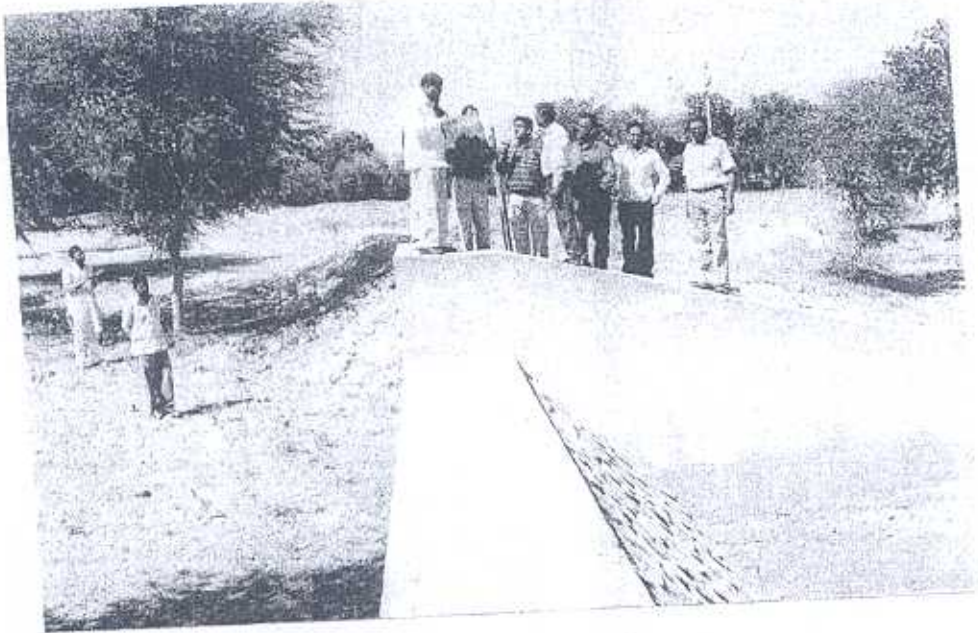


SEMAL ANICUT

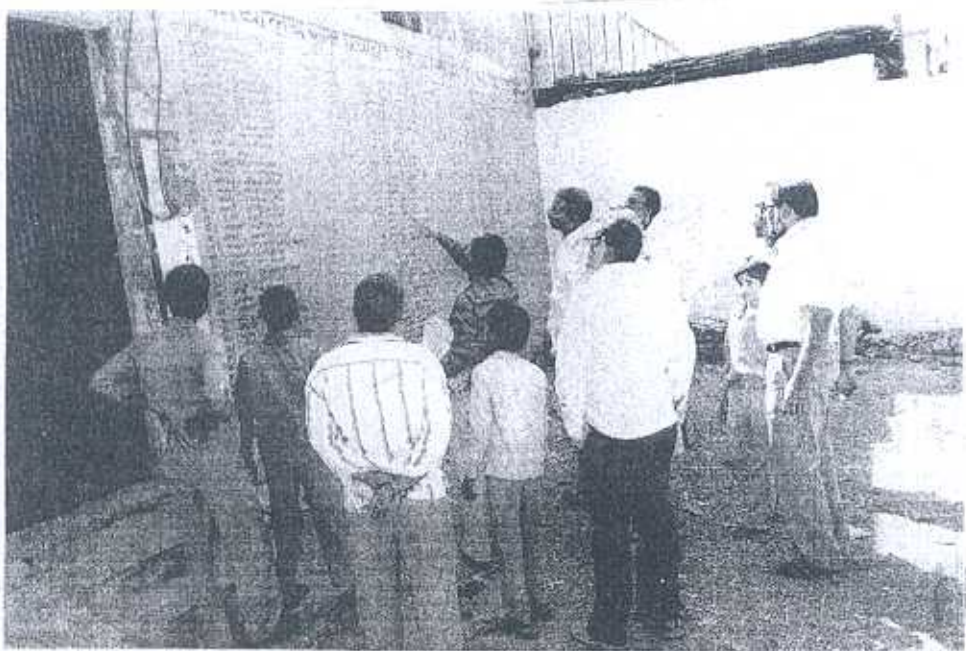

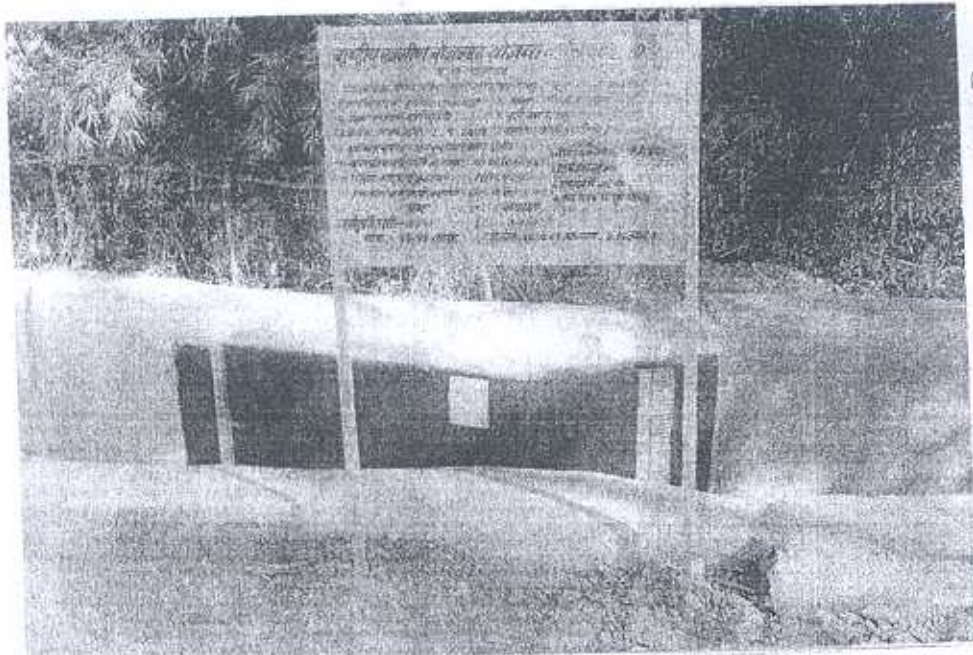

During my above inspection, I observed that, in Bilwara District only, during 2008-09 under NREGA programme, more than Rs.300/- Crores were utilized and during 2009-10 upto October-2009, again Rs.300/- Crores have been utilized. and it is extreme progress. In this District, labourers are not migrating to other Districts/States for seeking job, because they are getting daily work in their locality itself under NREGA programme. I also discussed with some labourers and local elected representatives and Grama Panchayat Staff, they are all very happy in saying that **“permanent assets have been created in this village”**. It confirmed to me that, this Government of India's scheme and aim of this scheme are fruitfully implementing in this District.
