Sub: Universalization of e-FMS implementation for all expenditure under MGNREGA -regarding.

Sir/ Madam,

Kindly refer to letter of even number dated 05th September, 2016 vide which it was requested that all the States/ UTs adopt an integrated Fund Management System called e-FMS (electronic Fund Management System) to ensure timely payments of wages, material and administrative expenses under MGNREGA.

2. The e-FMS implementation is regularly being reviewed by the Ministry and since September, 2016 the status of e-FMS implementation has improved in some States/UTs. At national level, the payments towards **material component has improved from 71% to 88% and for admin expenses from 58% to 70%.**

3. In order to review the progress and fast forward our endeavor towards universalizing e-FMS so that all types of payments (wages, Material and Admin) under MGNREGA are made only through e-FMS **a meeting is scheduled on 23rd January, 2017 at 11:00 AM in Unnati Hall, Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi.**

4. In the meeting, States/UTs are requested to present their strategy with timelines for 100% implementation of e-FMS. If there is any issue in meeting on the above objective or otherwise, States may also share the same with the Ministry.
