LABOUR BUDGET**

1. First login in to the district data entry page.
2. Secondly go to the section "Approved Labour Budget" as shown below under the section :: LABOUR BUDGET::
3. Fill the two forms as below and click on the save button:
 - a. Labour Demand
 - b. Work
4. *Persondays and expenditure figures have to be filled in "Lakhs".*

After login into the DISTRICT data entry page go to the labour budget section as shown below for entry of the approved LB for the FY 2010-11.
