The progress of "Standardization of village code/ unique location code across database" has been reviewed in the Ministry. It has been observed that uploading of details of village code /unique location code by the States/UT's has been very slow. The State-wise status of 'Census code Mapping' is enclosed for reference.

2. You are requested to ensure that all the required details are uploaded in NREGASoft at an early date. The paths for entering the details in NREGASoft are as follows:

1. Open Home Page i.e., [www.nrega.nic.in](http://www.nrega.nic.in)
2. Click on District/ Block Admin tab.
3. Then Click on 'Programme Officer' button.
4. Then Click on Data entry tab. After that, Click on the State name.
5. After clicking on State name, Data entry login window appears.
6. After login, Click on the tab 'Map Census Code as per Census 2011'.
7. Fill the details in Census code as per Census 2011 or verify the already mapped villages.
